The Berkshire Botanical Garden, founded in 1934, is one of the oldest public gardens in the United States. It is a lively center of special events, year-round educational programs for children and adults, and horticulture and, as the area's only botanical garden, is an important resource to the tri-state region it serves.

Over 300 volunteers dedicate more than 3,000 hours a year to the Garden and support many activities, including: Membership & Development, Special Events, Education, Office & Administration, Herb Associates, Horticulture, Garden Tours, and the Gift Shop & Visitor's Center.
