Leader-in-Training (LIT) Application

About Farm Camp: Farm in the Garden Camp is a day camp for children ages 5-14 located on the beautiful grounds of Berkshire Botanical Garden. A typical camp day might include making fresh goat cheese, extracting honey from our beehive, planting seeds in the garden, baking a treat with ingredients from the garden, and much more. Campers run a weekly farm stand for families and prepare a Friday Farm Feast to celebrate the fun and accomplishments of the week.

Farm in the Garden Camp 2020 has multiple openings for Leaders-In-Training (LITs) ages 15-18. Supervised by the Camp Director, LITs support educators in guiding campers through daily farm, garden, and craft activities. Camp runs Monday-Friday, 9:00 am to 3:00 pm from June 29 to August 14. LITs are required to commit to a minimum of 2 sessions of the summer. There will be a mandatory LIT training on Thursday, June 25 at Berkshire Botanical Garden. Time of training TBA.

Application Deadline:

Those interested in being a LIT should apply by April 1, 2020. Those who apply by then will be given priority and will be notified within the next two weeks if they have been accepted. Any applications received after April 1 will only be considered if spaces remain available.

LIT Responsibilities:

- Assist educators in set up, take down, and running of activities
- Interact with campers, help them complete crafts, activities, recipes, etc.
- Maintain the cob oven fire for the Friday Farm Feast
- Lead a game or activity; not required but highly encouraged
- Other duties as assigned

What you gain from being a LIT:

- Develop important leadership skills by observing educators and interacting with campers
- Learn not only the *types* of activities taught at Farm Camp, but more importantly *how* they are taught, organized, and planned
- Gain work references and employment skills
- Build the foundation for potential future work as a paid Camp Staff
- Get a stipend for your work (first time LITs earn \$125/week, returning LITs earn \$150/week)
- Be part of a fun and diverse community of children and educators (not to mention chickens, goats, rabbits, and sheep!)

Who should apply for a LIT position?

This position is for highly motivated teens (15-18 years old). Farm and Garden Camp LITs are enthusiastic about working with children, have a love of animals and the outdoors, and are interested in enhancing their leadership skills, including communication, teamwork, decision making, confidence, and creativity.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Qualified applicants will be interviewed in person or by phone.
