*Puschkinia scilloides* – Striped Squill

*Sanguinaria canadensis* – Bloodroot

*Scilla siberica* 'Little Blue' – Siberian Squill

*Trillium sessile* - Wakerobin

*Comptonia peregrina* - Sweetfern

*Cornus mas* – Corneliancherry Dogwood

*Dirca palustris* - Leatherwood

*Magnolia stellata* 'Centennial' – Star Magnolia

*Magnolia x loebneri* 'Merrill' – Loebner Magnolia

*Prunus sargentii* – Sargent Cherry
